The Georgia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce yet another development to benefit current and future members. The GHCC is joining with the North Metro Atlanta Chapter of SCORE in support of small businesses in the greater North Fulton area.

Since 1964, SCORE — a resource partner with the Small Business Association — has offered free, confidential services for those looking to start a business or expand an existing business. Across the country, 11,000 volunteers offer assistance through mentoring, workshops and resource libraries. The GHCC, for its part, serves members by promoting domestic and international economic development of Hispanic businesses and individuals, and by serving as a link between non-Hispanic entities and the Hispanic marketplace. This partnership between the two organizations is but a first step toward statewide cooperation.

Features of the partnership include cross-promotion of workshops, events and online support, and free, confidential business counseling at SCORE offices in Cobb, Gwinnett, Forsyth and Fulton Counties. Also of significant impact will be Spanish-speaking SCORE mentors that the two organizations will work together to engage and train.
