GHCC names 50 Most Influential Latinos for 2021

Atlanta, GA - The Georgia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce (GHCC) has announced its latest list of "50 Most Influential Latinos in Georgia."

"We are honored to recognize the '50 Most Influential Latinos in Georgia for 2021.' Our awards recognition stands as a beacon of hope, inspiration and a celebration of achievement and contribution to our society," said Veronica Maldonado-Torres, GHCC president and CEO.

The honorees were announced at an event Sept. 1 at Truist Park and aired online Sept. 9.

The Most Influential list includes people from business, sports, entertainment and politics, including such notables as: 100 Black Men of Atlanta Executive Director and COO Louis Negron, APS Board Chair Jason Esteves, GALEO Executive Director Jerry Gonzalez, Georgia State Representative Zulma Lopez, Georgia Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner John King, TV journalist Wendy Corona, Georgia Power Area Manager Misty Fernandez, Dr. Carlos del Rio of Emory University and Carolina Ramon, Director at UGA SBDC Office of Minority Business Development, among others.

The GHCC also announced the latest inductees to its Hall of Fame, including retired UPS Foundation President Ed Martinez, Norsan Group CEO Norberto Sanchez, Ser Familia's Belisa and Michael Urbina, Telemundo Atlanta General Manager Ivan Shammas and Univision Communications Regional Community Empowerment Director Mariela Romero.

"Honoring and highlighting the powerful contributions of our 50 Most Influential Latinos in Georgia is our duty and we proudly elevate them in character, impact, connectivity and honor their role in our communities," Maldonado-Torres added.

The over 300 nominations that the GHCC received this year went through a rigorous process to evaluate contributions each nominee has made. The final selection was based on the degree of influence each person exhibited in their role as a representative of the Latino community.
